Suggestions of ways to use concept cards



Identifying Concepts

- Give each student a concept card related to the themes of your inquiry
- Ask them to hold up their card when the concept on it arises

Keywording Concepts

- Write a concept word on a blank card each time one arises in the students' discussion.
- Stick the cards on a flip-chart and use them to help in question forming

Highlighting Concepts

- Use one or two large cards showing the concepts you want the discussion to focus on
- Ask the students to try to connect their comments to the chosen concepts

Recording Concepts

- Write a concept word on a blank card each time one arises in the students' discussion.
- Stick the cards on a wall display for the students to look at during the week

You can show the cards direct from the pdf or you can print them out an cut them into individual cards
