



Metacognition

Teachers and students need a common vocabulary of thinking to use in enquiry and general learning



Effective metacognition and self-regulation:

- Can accelerate progress by 7 months
- Helps lower achieving students catch up
- Is best taught and learned collaboratively
- Is a low-cost intervention

What do you think will happen?




What can you recall from ...?


