Rebecca: Hello! Wondered if anyone could offer some stimulus ideas for looking after our environment for year 6s please?

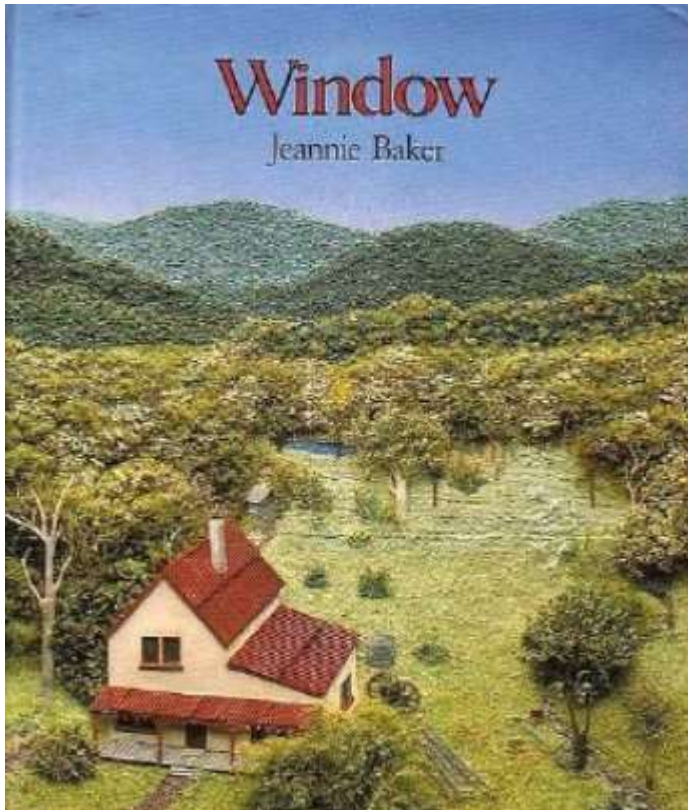

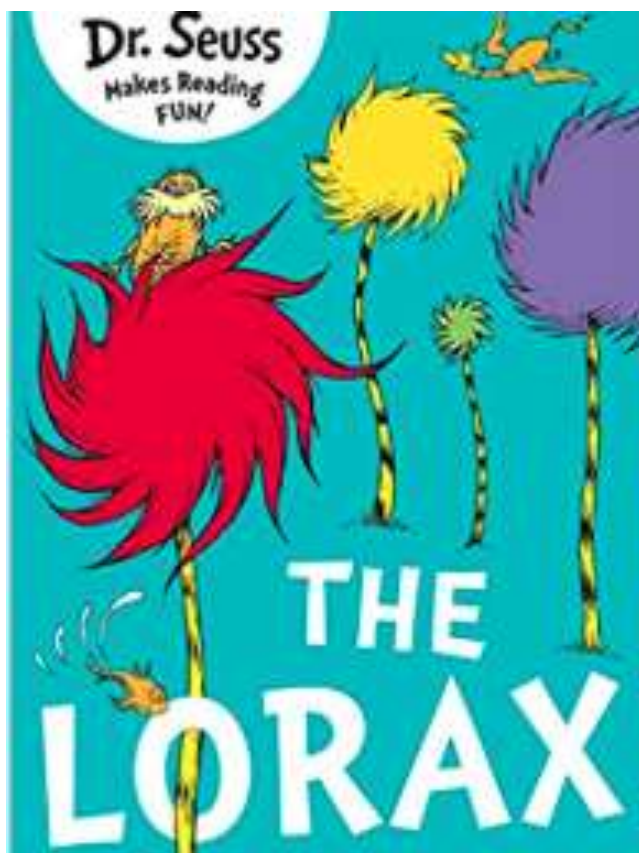
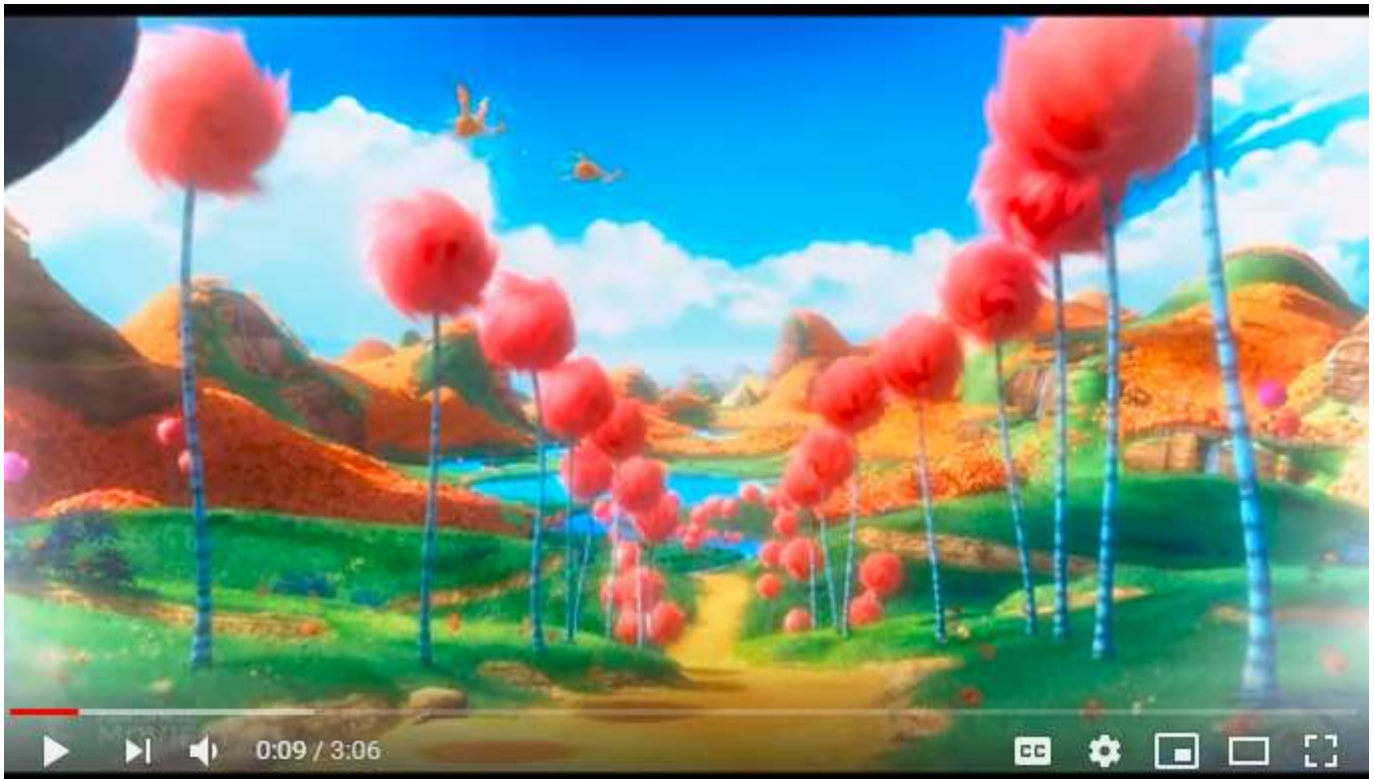


Nick: This picture from NASA shows the whole world at night. Good for showing not just the amount of electricity consumption but also where it all is.
